KALARIPPAYATTU

Kalarippayattu is known worldwide as "The mother of martial arts" Originally it is a great martial science. Art is a part of it.

It is related to "Vedas" the existence of Indian culture and is inherited from "Sri Parameswara" the "Omnipotent master of all arts and science, to his disciple "Sri Parasurama" and from "Sri Parasurama" it is provided to the whole humanity. So "Sri Parasurama" is believed and worshipped as "The Master of Kalarippayattu".

Through kalarippayattu, the scientific ways of defencing, attacking methods can be obtained and gain authority over the opponent and will help a person to develop his personality. It also develops "splendour, beauty, concentration, originality, determination, spirituality, willpower, wisdom, knowledge, creativity, patriotism, adventure, body science and all the trainings which help a person's overall development.

When kalarippayattu comes to Kalari chikilsa (treatment) the great Martial art is converted to science of living.



KALARI - SYLLABUS, SUBJECTS

The place where 'kalarippayattu' is being practised is known as "kalari" It is also believed that the word kalari is originated from 'Khalurika' the name of a goddess. Mainly there are two versions of kalari. The first one is ancestral, known as "Nalpatheeradi" and the second is martial training and 'duel', known as "Arupathinaleeradi"

"Akkanadan's sree chakram kalari' is derived from Ancestral- Nalpatheeradi kuzhithara kalari division.

Akkanadan's Kalari is built East West with 42 yard of length, 21 yard of width and 17.5 yard of height in 'gaja yoni', according to the Indian architectural methods. For temperature balance it is built 6 yard below from the ground level. In the south west part of the kalari" Poothara" is located in 'kanni raasi'. The part with a triangle shaped bud upon the 7 steps is known as 'Poothara'. The 7 steps are imagined as the 7 mother goddesses- "Braahmi, Maheswari, Koumari, Vaishnavi, Varahi, Indrani and Chamunda.

The students are worshipping the left side of the bud as 'Sri Parameswara' and the right side of the bud as "Bhadrakali- the house hold deity "This is imagined as the mingling up of siva and Saktheya. Next to Poothara, at the west part of the Kalari, these are Veera Ganapathi, Nagayakshi, Traditional gurus, Veerabhadran, Hanuman and Subrahmanya. The icons of Ayyappan and Srichakra are installed in proper places and are worshipped accordingly.

The floor of the Kalari is prepared specially with some medicinal compounds. This medicated floor is maintained and protected very carefully over the periods.

The most serious method of kalari "Arappakkai" is being practised here. The syllabus contains, " Meithari, kolthari, Ankathari, Verum Kai, Marmasathra, Chikitsa, manthrik, Thanthrik and Vedic Subjects.













SPIRITUALITY





Akkanadu family has centuries of oldness and tradition and at the time of King's rule it was the ministerial house. This great family gave birth to great Magicians, Upasakar, astrologers Sanskrit Scholars (like N. Raghava menon, Narayana menon etc) and great warriors.

The Prominent person among the predecessors of that great family is Devaki amma teacher who gives supervision to all the activities of kalari and temple. Respected Sri Vasudeva menon also gives guidance to the activities.

The August presence of 'mahabhadrakali' the household deity of Akkanadan's family gives blessings and virtues to the kalari, the students and moreover to the whole humanity. The temple of Akkanadu which is situated in 'Kanni rasi' the Kalari and the Elengi tree at the courtyard and the choral kavu and the pond behind it pouring to us spiritual feelings.

There are Phanapanchaka Nagaraja, Triphana Nagayakshi, Akhila Sarpangal with adharma sarpangal are installed in Meenam rasi, Facing west, in the middle of the beautiful landscape of grove and pond. They are Dwelling here protecting the treasure, grain, money and matters. Upadevathas like Brahmarakshas, Yogeeswaran, Marutha Arukola (Veeramrithya Yodhav) are also installed inside the temple.
